Volunteers Needed

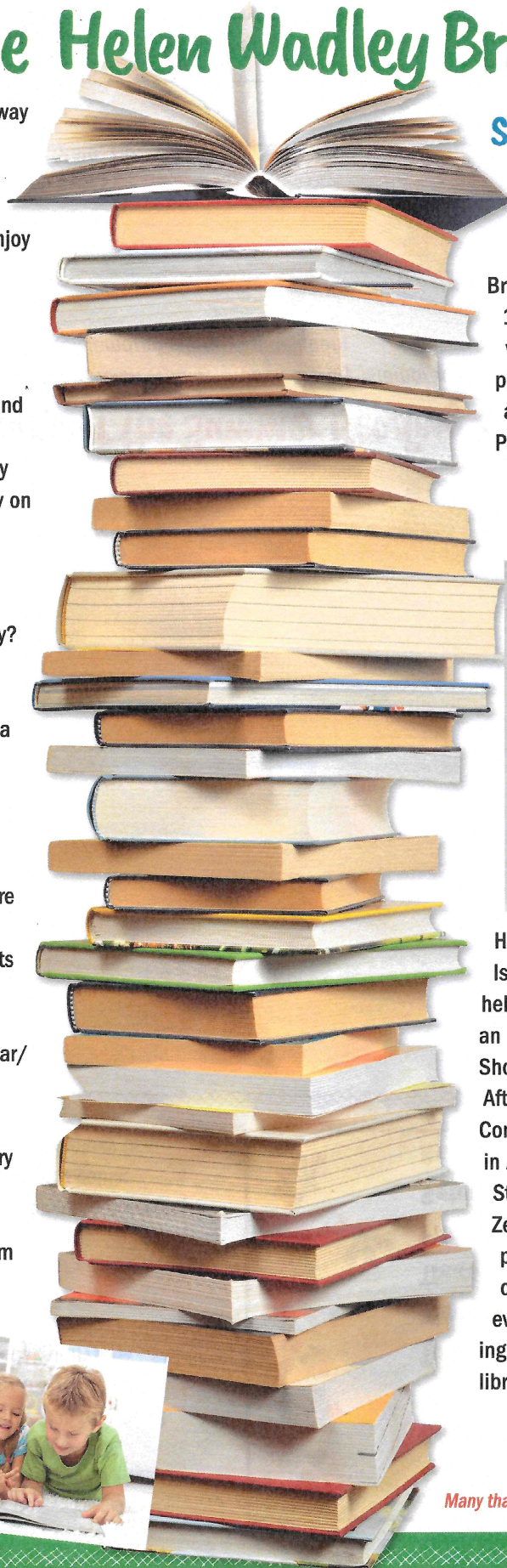

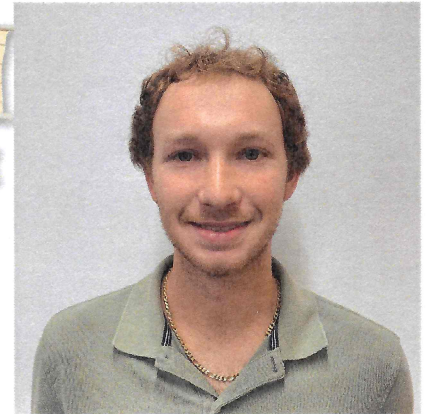


Story Time With Ms. Chris
